

## To Apply to the UAMS Geriatric Psychiatry Fellowship Program

Thank you for your interest in our geriatric psychiatry fellowship program. You must have completed a four year general psychiatry residency to be considered for our program.

- A current CV;
- A letter of recommendation from your current psychiatry training director verifying satisfactory completion (or anticipated completion) of all educational and ethical requirements for graduation;
- Two additional letters of recommendation; These letters are to be sent directly by the authors of the letters.
- An original copy of your medical school transcript; Sent directly from the medical school.
- A copy of your USMLE or COMLEX transcript (with all three scores and attempts)
- ECFMG certificate (for foreign medical school graduates);
- A personal statement regarding your interest in the field of geriatric psychiatry;

Our deadline for applications is December 1; however, we strongly recommend that you submit your application materials as soon as possible. Your application packet will be reviewed by the fellowship director when all requested materials are received. Please note that acceptance into our program is contingent upon your ability to obtain a valid Arkansas medical license.
