Internship Program Admissions

Our 2080-hour clinical psychology internship is designed to provide interns with a broad and general training experience in basic principles and techniques of professional psychology. It is sponsored by UAMS and Arkansas Children's Hospital and offers training through adult, child, or neuropsychology tracks. The internship is one of the training programs of the Department of Psychiatry in the UAMS College of Medicine with multiple training sites – the Walker Family Clinic, Women's Mental Health Clinic, and the Child Diagnostic Unit located in the Psychiatric Research Institute; Student Wellness Clinic; the Child Study Center and Burn Center at Arkansas Children's Hospital; and the Pulaski County Crisis Stabilization Unit. Psychiatry residents and fellows, as well as social work interns, are also part of the training programs within the department. The internship training year is July 1 through June 30 of each year.
